# 70 YEARS OF NISSAN ELECTRIC VEHICLES

1947

Launch of the Tama EV, built by Tokyo Electro Automobile Co Ltd (later bought by Nissan)

1970

Nissan 315X two-door EV city car concept unveiled at Tokyo Motor Show

1995

FEV II concept car, powered by lithium-ion batteries, debuts at Tokyo Motor Show

1983

Nissan March EV, an experimental compact hatchback, revealed

1991

FEV concept car for short-range driving exhibited at 1991 Tokyo Motor Show

1996

Prairie Joy EV, world's first electric vehicle featuring a cylindrical lithium-ion battery

2005

PIVO concept showcases Nissan's compact lithium-ion battery

2007

The Mixin concept car revealed, powered by electric motor / generator with compact lithium-ion batteries

2008

Nissan unveils all-electric prototype vehicle equipped with a laminated lithium-ion battery. Called NUVU, it previewed some of the technology that would later appear on the Nissan LEAF

November 2010

LEAF wins European Car of the Year 2011

December 2010

Global launch of the Nissan LEAF. Released on sale in the USA and Japan

March 2011

European launch of the LEAF

April 2011

LEAF wins World Car of the Year

July 2012

LEAF takes the world record for the fastest car over a mile in reverse

July 2017

Nissan BladeGlider debuts at Goodwood Festival of Speed

September 2017

The new #Nissan #LEAF, unveiled

March 2016

Nissan unveils the Fuel Station of the Future at Geneva Motor Show

October 2015

European launch of the Nissan LEAF 30kWh
