

NISSAN'S TOP 10 TRAILER TOWING TIPS



1



Ensure your trailer and vehicle are a match.

Consult your owner's manual for the maximum trailer weight and tongue load.

2



Check all fluids—especially oil and coolant levels.

Towing puts an extra strain on a vehicle, especially in summer.



The **Vehicle Information Display** on the TITAN includes auxiliary gauges to help monitor engine and transmission temperatures.

Maintain correct tire pressure for tow vehicle and trailer.

And don't forget the spare!



Easy-Fill Tire Alert is available on a range of Nissan products and eliminates the need for a tire pressure gauge when inflating tires. The vehicle simply “honks” when the tire reaches the correct pressure.

Be sure to have the proper jack(s) and lug wrench(es)

for your trailer (and/or spare tire) because your normal jack might not fit everything you need.

5



Check and lubricate trailer wheel bearings

at the beginning of each season, and even more frequently if submerged in water like when launching a boat.

6



Ensure you have the proper hitch.

Your drawbar will be at the correct height when your trailer sits level when coupled. And be sure you have the right size tow ball to match your trailer coupler.

7



Be sure the safety chains are connected and properly

crossed, not in danger of dragging on the ground. If you have a trailer with brakes, don't forget to connect the cable for the breakaway switch.

8



Connect your trailer wiring,

with either a flat, 4-pin connector for light duty trailers or a 7-pin connector for trailers with brakes. A great way to make sure connectors stay free of corrosion is to add some dielectric grease to the pins.

9



Always check trailer lights are functioning properly.



Nissan's **Trailer Light Check**, available on TITAN and TITAN XD makes checking trailer lights as simple as pressing a button on the key fob.

10



Adjust the gain and boost settings on your trailer brake controller

according to the manufacturer's recommendations. And when you start to roll-out, be sure to check your trailer brakes are operating early by using the manual switch on the controller. You should feel an immediate drag on the tow vehicle.
